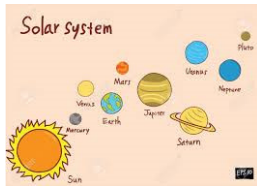


Space- draw the planets in our solar system and name them. Which is your favourite and why?
