**Nature of support 2020/21 (Strict Covid regulations in place limiting actions)**

**Provision of Sports Training for Staff**

- Ensuring the school PE resources reflect the needs of both the curriculum and its growing numbers on roll through the maintenance & replacing of broken equipment.
- Ensuring the quality of the physical education, particularly team, racket & net and some outdoor adventurous activities through the employment of Up & Under qualified sports coaches to deliver at least 1 session of PE each week to pupils in KS2.
- Due to the restrictions relating to Covid the decision was taken to roll funds forward in order to resource the back playground with a range of equipment that will encourage strength, agility and balance during the 2021-2022 academic year.

**Extend the range of after school sports activities**

**Curriculum focus of Sports Grant spending 2021/2022**

Continue to provide at least 3 clubs per term from Up and Under Sports

Further extend sports resources available to pupils at playtimes and encourage additional inter-house competition.

Re instatement of swimming opportunities.

Provide quality PE sessions for pupils in Yr1-Y6 through the use of qualified sports coaches.

Further extend physical development opportunities at playtimes through the instalment of a range of climbing and balancing activities on the back playground.
