Mr Gibbens began by reviewing the findings of the E-safety parental survey:

- **E-safety update** – CG explained that we had analysed the 50 responses we had received and would feedback our findings – CG issued SMART and age restrictions to the meeting.

CG also explained that the top 3 suggestions would be acted upon:

- **Websites to help learning and which sites we use in school – a list of sites for KS1 and KS2**
- **Age restrictions and SMART guidance to be published on website**
- **How we cover E-safety in school – what does that look like in KS1 and KS2**

These are the main findings but purely suggestions at this stage

- **See-Saw** – parked until September – just need to iron out some user issues.
- **Re-cycling** options – now happening through Wiltshire Wildlife Trust.
- **Building update** – should be completed during the February half term – CG explained the roof was the major issue. New doors were to be fitted and new water-resistant flooring to be fitted in Ducklings and Goslings

New Issues raised:

- **Breakfast Club** – entrance is becoming dangerous – swinging on the scaffolding/walking across the grass – could we do something about it please
- **Phase 2** – CG explained we are not growing as fast as we hoped so Phase 2 is not likely to happen soon.
- **Year 3** – question was asked as the numbers grow were there plans to make changes as we did last year. CG explained a letter was being sent as we speak.
