Queen's Jubilee Event

To celebrate the Queen's Jubilee, Priestley Primary School are going to be holding a Jubilee Event at the school on Monday, 23 May 2022.

During the school day children will be taking part in Jubilee related activities in the morning and then enjoying a street party in the afternoon, followed by a Fete after school, from 3 pm to 4 pm, for parents, carers and families to attend.

We will be holding two Jubilee competitions, which will be judged on the day:

- Best Hat
- Celebration Cake

Lunch on this day will be in keeping with the 1950's and will be traditional fish and chips (please do not worry that the choice shown on ParentPay is southern fried chicken, this will be substituted on the day). The vegetarian choice will stay the same (jacket potato) then followed by jelly and ice cream. If you would like your child to have lunch on this day, please order in the usual way on ParentPay.

To get into the spirit of the event we will be asking for the staff and children to dress up in outfits similar to those worn in the 1950's when the Queen came to the throne.

There will be a live retro band playing music through the decades from the 1950's up to the present day.

At the Fete there will be various stalls including: drinks, sweets, cake, games, etc and a raffle with lots of amazing prizes.

Prior to the day we will be running a raffle for the children to win a chocolate hamper. Each class will have their own hamper to win. Tickets will be 50p each and children will be able to purchase tickets from their class teachers from w/c Monday, 9 May. The winning tickets for each class will be drawn at the Fete on Monday, 23 May.
