## **KS2 - HARVEST FESTIVAL ASSEMBLY**

Following the success of previous years, we wish to see the return of our Harvest Festival celebration. With our ever-growing numbers, this year's Harvest Festival will be split in to two celebrations. One for KS1 and one for KS2. This year, celebrations will take place in the afternoon, in the school hall.

We would like to invite you to celebrate with us on **Friday 14 October**. Please arrive in time for a prompt **2.10 pm** start in the school hall. The assembly will last approximately one hour. Entry into will be permitted through **the outside doors into the hall**. Once the assembly is finished, please make your way back through these doors and round to the playground to collect your child at the end of the day, from their normal exits.

In order to support the local community, we will be collecting dry and tinned goods. These will then be donated to the Calne Food Bank. The food bank provides emergency food parcels for people experiencing a temporary financial crisis. During the period leading up to the Harvest Festival, we are asking the children to bring in items of food to support this very worthwhile cause.

We would really appreciate it if you could send your child into school with one or two items from the list below, which they should take to their classroom. If you wish to send more it will be greatly received. (Please make sure that everything has a 3-month shelf-life.)

In order for us to display the food during our Harvest Assembly, we will need to receive your donations by Wednesday, 12 October 2022.
